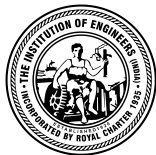

2.0 Personal Information

- Age : Minimum 40 years on the date of Application.
- Name should be as per BE/B.Tech/Equivalent Certificate. Pin Code no. must be mentioned by the Applicant correctly for attachment of Centre. **Mobile No. and e-mail are mandatory requirements.**

3.0 Educational Qualification

B.E./B.Tech or equivalent qualification recognized by the Institution. Other qualification may be accepted in consultation with the Equivalence Committee.

4.0 Abridged Eligibility Guideline (Experience)

4.1 'Position of High Responsibility' for:-

- Universities / Degree Engg Colleges will be taken to start from:
 - Professors in Pay Band – IV (PB-IV) i.e. those placed in scale of pay: Rs.37400 – 67000 with minimum Grade Pay: Rs.10000.
 - Associate Professors in Pay Band – IV (PB-IV) i.e. those placed in scale of pay: Rs.37400 – 67000 with minimum Grade Pay: Rs.9000.
 - Assistant Professors on completion of 3 years of service and in the scale of PB-IV i.e. Rs.37400 – 67000 with minimum Grade Pay: Rs.9000.
- Employees in PSUs, will be taken to start from the pay scale of Rs.36600 – 62000 following the BPE norms of pay scale. The qualifying criteria like pay scale at a particular level shall be reviewed after Central Govt Pay revision/ Bureau of Public Enterprises (BPE pay scales).
- Indian Army will be taken to start from Lt. Col. and equivalent posts in Indian Navy and Air Force.
- Other Central/State Govt Employees will, in general be taken to start from PB-IV i.e. those placed in scale of pay: Rs.37400 – 67000 after the implementation of 6th CPC recommendation.

In case the PB-IV scale (i.e. Rs. 37400 – 67000) is absent in the pay-structure of any State Government organization, the applicant will be eligible for FIE on satisfaction of any of the following conditions:

Basic Pay per month: Rs.40,000 (or above)

or

Gross Pay per month: Rs.80,000 (or above)

- (e) CSIR, other Research Laboratories/ Institution will, in general be taken to start from Scientists and Engineers in Pay scale: Rs.37400 – 67000.
- (f) Polytechnics will be at the level of Principals in the scale of pay: Rs.37400 – 67000.

Post qualification experience of 15 years in abovementioned posts(s) and equivalent post(s) in other organization shall be considered for Fellowship (FIE).

- 4.2 In case of applicants employed as Faculty members in Polytechnics who are placed in the scale of pay: Rs.37400 – 67000 or Executive Engineers (PB-3) in Central / State govt. organization will be considered for Fellowship on satisfaction of any of the following conditions:

- (a) If the highest qualification of the applicant is BE/B.Tech or equivalent qualification in Engineering, then a minimum post qualification experience required is 20 years along with a minimum tenure of 8 years in the present and/or promoted position.
- (b) If the highest qualification of the applicant is ME/M.Tech or equivalent qualification in Engineering, then a minimum post qualification experience required is 18 years along with a minimum residency/tenure of 6 years in the present and/or promoted position.
- (c) If the highest qualification of the applicant is PhD or equivalent qualification in Engineering, then a minimum post qualification experience required is 16 years along with a minimum tenure of 4 years in the present and/or promoted position.

- 4.3 In case of FIE applicants who are working in Private organization or are Self Employed, the minimum number of years of experience should be 20 years, provided the applicant doesn't have a post graduate degree in Engineering. This minimum requirement of number of years of experience will be reduced by 2 years for every higher degree upto PhD. Hence, for a Private Professional/ Self-Employed applicant for Fellowship, a minimum post qualification experience of 18 years will be required if he/she has a postgraduate degree in Engineering and 16 years will be required if his/her highest qualification be PhD.

- 4.4 In case of Self Employed applicants for Fellowship, an assessment procedure would be exercised as per the methodology approved by the Council.

- 4.5 The applicants who are working in Private organization will be eligible for FIE on satisfaction of Clause 4.3 along with all the following conditions:

- (a) The profile of the company/ the group of companies (as reflected through its website) should be up to the satisfaction of the Membership Committee. The company/ the group of companies, therefore, must have an official website.
- (b) Monthly salary/compensation package of the applicant should satisfy any of the following conditions:

Minimum Basic Salary per month – Rs. 50,000

or

Minimum Gross Salary per month – Rs. 1,00,000

or

Minimum Cost to Company (CTC) per month – Rs. 1,50,000.

- (c) Minimum designation should be Manager or equivalent. The equivalence of the designation/rank may be decided by the competent authority.

- 4.6 In case of persons having passed Sections A and B of the Institution Examinations, period of experience shall be reckoned from the date of passing Section A Examination subject to a maximum one year prior to the passing of Section B Examination.

5.0 Documents to be attached [Photo copies to be either self attested or attested by the supporter (FIE)]

- a. Certificate in support of Date of Birth.
- b. Certificate in support of examinations passed including BE/B.TECH final pass certificate (or marksheets with Provisional Certificate).
- c. Documentary proof in support of Present Position/Designation. For retired persons, proof in support of last held position/designation.
- d. Documentary proof in support of salary e.g. payslip/salary certificate etc. (showing pay band and grade pay) for employed persons. For retired persons, proof in support of last drawn salary should be attached.
- e. For Self Employed Persons, following additional documents should be attached:
i) Company Profile, ii) Age of the Organisation, iii) Annual Turnover of the Organisation for last 3 years (duly certified by a Chartered Accountant), iv) Number of Technical Personnel Engaged in the Organization with details of hierarchy and the Position of the Applicant therein, v) Important jobs/projects executed during last five years and the involvement of the Applicant therein, vi) Contribution to the society through the product or service of the Company, and vii) Administrative/Management experience and/or Professional Attainments, if any.
- f. Attested copy of Documentary Evidence (e.g. Marriage Certificate or Affidavit from First Class Magistrate) must be enclosed in support of Change in Name (if any). (No request for change in name is entertained after enrolment).

N.B. : ALL OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS MUST BE EITHER SELF ATTESTED OR ATTESTED BY THE SUPPORTER OF THE APPLICATION.

6.0 Choice of Engineering Discipline/Division

- a. The applicant shall be attached to any one of the following Engineering Divisions as per his/her engineering qualification and professional experience. Choice of attachment to any Division needs to be supported by adequate proof of qualification/ expertise/experience in that Division.

- b. Applicant should not opt for the engineering division in which he/she wants to appear in additional branch in Section B examination of the Institution.

7.0 Application for Chartered Engineer Certificate

As per the Declaration No. 16 of the Royal Charter, 1935 and Clause 69(i) of the Bye Laws & Regulations of the Institution, every Life Corporate Member (FIE/MIE/AMIE) is entitled to use the style and title of Chartered Engineer (India) and can use the description as C.Eng(I) after his/her name. Soft copies of The Royal Charter and the Bye Laws & Regulations of the Institution are available at IEI website www.ieindia.org. Any Life Corporate Member may apply for Chartered Engineer Certificate with necessary fee as per the Table below.

It has been observed that the Chartered Engineer certificate is often useful for the following purpose:-

- To be empaneled as Valuer, Loss Assessor in various financial institutions like Banks, Insurance companies etc.
- To be empaneled as Chartered Engineer in the Original Side of High Courts, Central Excise and Customs and other similar govt concerns.
- To win contract of civil works from Municipal Corporation and similar govt bodies.
- To have better opportunity of being employed and/or promoted in foreign companies.
- To practice as self employed consultant in India and abroad.

In general, the Chartered Engineer certificate being issued by the IEI, plays the role of recognition and acceptance of one's techno-academic qualification and professional attainment on a global platform.

8.0 Other Information

- Applicants residing in abroad must remit the fee in US \$ only.
- Complete Application Form along with all necessary Documents duly signed by existing Corporate Member (FIE) must be sent by the Applicant directly to the Headquarters of the Institution at 8 Gokhale Road, Kolkata 700 020 **and NOT through any Agency.**
- Applicants are advised to keep the photocopies of the filled in Application Form along with the demand draft and all documents attached therewith for information and future reference.
- Any deficiency/discrepancy in the Application Form is intimated by sending a Letter to the Applicant. Also, month wise list of such 'Discrepancy in Application' with details are available at our website www.ieindia.org. Every applicant should positively comply his/her discrepancy (if any) within One year. Failure may liable the application to be cancelled.
- In case a candidate is not eligible for election, he/she is eligible for refund of his/her Entrance Fee and the amount deposited for

Composite Subscription, without any interest thereon, after deducting non-refundable Registration Fee and General Office Charges as per Regulation. The same is also applicable for applications cancelled because of non-receipt of compliance of discrepancy within the stipulated timeline.

- f. Every Applicant should carefully note the DD/Cheque no. and the unique Reference No. received by SMS/IVRS and refer the same for all future correspondence with IEI.
- g. **The decision on every Application rests with the Council of IEI only, which is final and binding on the Applicant.**

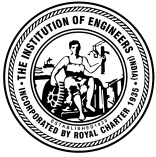

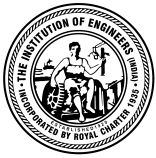
